- 1. Introduction of Brian Mahoney and Kevin Scribner: Mahoney and Scribner introduced themselves as consultants for the work group.

- 6. Scope of VSP: The group discussed whether municipalities are included in VSP; it would appear there is some overlap such as ag activities occurring on city-owned property and the Mill Creek
